Wardrobe declutter

DITCH THE PLASTIC COVERING

'The first thing I do when I open a client's wardrobe is throw away old dry-cleaning plastic sheeting. So many clients keep these to protect clothes, but it's actually bad for the fabric. The plastic coverings trap dry cleaning chemicals and the fabric is left unable to breathe. Throw away the plastic and use a zipped up self bag instead.'

DON'T OVERTHINK IT

'The longer you spend looking at an item of clothing, the easier it is to persuade yourself to keep it. Give yourself just a couple of seconds to make a decision on each garment. More often than not, you will know quickly if it's a piece of clothing you love and wear. The process will be quicker and more enjoyable as a result.'

DITCH THE WOODEN HANGERS

'Wooden hangers are more attractive than wire hangers, but they take up a lot of space. They are too bulky and not ideal for the items of clothing that slip off easily. Ditch the wooden hangers and opt for the non-slip hangers instead. They save space and you won't lose items into the depths of your wardrobe floor.'

ORGANISE BY STYLE, NOT COLOUR

'Organising your wardrobe in colour order may look more attractive, but it won't save you time in the mornings. Instead, organise by style and purpose. Keep the clothes that you need more often in the middle of your wardrobe. By separating your wardrobe into workwear, casual wear and occasion wear, it will make it easier planning your outfits.'
